YEAR 1 LEARNING PLAN

I would like to inform you of the learning in year 1 over the next half term. It would be of great benefit to your child's progress if you provided help and support in these areas. *Ustaadah Sheba*

Maths

Unit 3 and 4 - addition and subtraction within 10. It builds children's knowledge of number bonds within 10, their ability to use a number line to count forwards and backwards and their understanding that two parts make a whole in the context of subtraction.

Unit 5 Geometry - Properties of shapes- 2D and 3D shapes
It draws on their skills of identifying similarities and differences and making direct comparisons, and develops their skills of identifying patterns and sequences in shapes.

Unit 6 Number - Number and place value- Numbers to 20
Children will count in tens and ones, learning that they can partition 2-digit numbers into tens and ones. They will find the number that is one more or one less than a given number.

English

Phonics

Introducing Phase 3 sounds. Revision, spelling and handwriting of phase 2 and 3 sounds. Recognise and practise tricky words

Theme - Heroes and Villains

- I Want my Hat Back by Jan Klassen
During this sequence through role-play, they will explore a character's feelings. Making inferences on the basis of what is being said and done. Participating in discussion, taking turns and listening to what others say. Sequencing sentences to form short narratives. Plan their own sequel called, 'I Want My Friend Back'.

- Billy and the Beast by Nadia Shireen
Children create their own version of the Billy character and use them to defeat a terrible beast. Give advice, write a letter and create their own versions of a Billy and the Beast story.

Introduction of question marks, exclamation marks, speech bubbles and how to join sentences using 'and'.

Qur'an, Arabic and Islamic Studies

Quran:
Surah revision from Nas to Al Zalzalah
New Surahs: Bayannah and Qadr
Reciting slowly with madd and ghunnah

Qaida
Mixed short vowels word revision
Tanween/double fatha, kasra and dhamma

Islamic Studies:
Learning the basics of salaah, names of salaah
The importance of the five pillars in Islam
Prophets Adam, Nuh and Ibraheem alaihi salam
Duas for waking up, sleeping, before and after eating
Arabic:
Recognising individual letters in word.
Writing Arabic words to match the initial Arabic letter

Foundation Subjects

SCIENCE - Scientists and inventors

HISTORY - Toys Past and Present

The importance of not harming others and keeping ourselves safe. Reading our morning and evening adhkaar/duas for leaving the house, etc.

COMPUTING - Developing basic computer skills
By the end of the unit, children should be able to:

• type letters and symbols, including use of the shift key;
• format text in different ways (bold, italic, underline)
