Maths

Unit 16
• **Numbers to 100**
In this unit, children will develop their understanding of, and ability to manipulate, numbers to 100. They will investigate patterns in 2-digit numbers, specifically 1 more and 1 less, and 10 more and 10 less, before moving on to partition numbers and identify the place value of digits within a number.

Unit 17
• **Time**
This unit introduces children to various aspects of time. Children will develop their ability to tell the time by reading an analogue clock or watch, estimating and comparing durations, and carrying out simple calculations involving time.

Unit 18
• **Money**
This unit draws on the key skills of reading and writing numbers, counting and addition. It focuses on recognising coins and banknotes and understanding their relative and absolute values.

English

LITERACY
Theme: imagination and creativity.

Iggy Peck, Architect by Andrea Beatty and David Roberts
Children develop reading skills of prediction and inference. They will have the opportunity to practise use of basic sentence punctuation and creating compound sentences before exploring features of famous buildings. Labelling the features and learning about apostrophes for omission and possession. They will create a fact file where they incorporate the learning they have experienced over the course of the sequence.

The Magic Bed by John Burningham
The children read some stories where fantasy worlds are represented, for example imaginary lands, space, animal homes. They will read common exception words, and words containing taught GPCs and -s, -es, -ing, -ed, -er and -est endings. Be encouraged to link what they read or hear to their own experiences. Write sentences by composing a sentence orally before writing it. Sequencing sentences to form short narratives.
