YEAR 3 LEARNING PLAN

Ustadah Amal

English

We will be reading **Jim, a Cautionary Tale** by Hilaire Belloc and Mini Grey and **The Day I Swapped My Dad for Two Goldfish** by Neil Gaiman. We will be listening and discussing a wide range of books and poetry, as well as discussing writing similar to that which we are planning to write in order to understand and learn from its structure, vocabulary and grammar. We will continue using conjunctions and adverbs, and choose nouns or pronouns appropriately for clarity and cohesion and to avoid repetition.

Maths

We will continue with our unit **Time**. We will learn to convert between units of time. We will be introduced to the concept of the 24-hour clock. Our next unit is **Geometry**, where we will continue to learn about horizontal and vertical lines, including symmetry, parallel and perpendicular lines, and recognise acute, obtuse, and right angles. We will name and describe the different types of triangles and quadrilaterals. Our final unit is **Measurement - Mass and Capacity**. In this unit, we will measure mass and capacity in different units (e.g. grams, kilograms, litres, millilitres), we will work out different intervals on a scale, compare masses and capacities, and solve word problems involving masses and capacities.

Quran

Revision of Surah Abasa

Children will be practising Bridge to Quran- 3/4 words. To carry on a similar concept from the previous half term; Huroof As-Shamsiyyah and Qamariyyah (Sun & Moon letters). Knowledge of this topic will help to merge two words confidently and improve fluency in reading.

Arabic

Children will be learning how to say different places in the locality in Arabic. They will construct short sentences with the verbs "I go to the..." and "I come back from ...with my- family members" verbally and in written form.

Islamic Studies

- We will practice the daily Salaah with all the Adhkaar and Dua's.
- Children will be learning the etiquette when coming to the Musallah.
- They will also learn the elements which break their salah (Breakers of salah).
- The impact of TV, music and games.
- The way one should respect the parents.
- Seerah of the prophet (pbuh) on Friday.
