We would like to inform you of the different topics we are covering in Year 4 this half term. It would be of great benefit to your child's progress if you provided help and support in these areas at home.

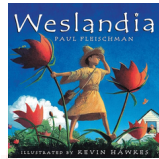

English

Book: Weslandia by Paul Fleischman and Kevin Hawkes
continued

- Writing brochures, non-chronological reports, character descriptions and story re-telling.
- Learning word families based on common words, showing how words are related in form and meaning e.g. solve, solution, solver, dissolve, insoluble.



Book: Jabberwocky by Lewis Carroll and Joel Stewart

- Performance poetry, explanatory descriptions and character dialogues.
- Recognising different forms of poetry e.g. free verse, acrostic, limerick.



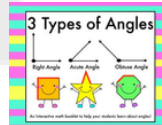
Maths

Unit 13 - Time

- 24 hour clock/converting between units of time.
- Solving word problems involving time.

Unit 14 - Statistics

- Children explore pictograms, bar charts and tables in detail.
- Using data presented in line graphs for the first time and the difference between continuous and discrete data.

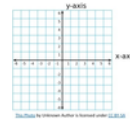


Unit 15 - Geometry - Angles and 2D Shapes

- The three types of angles: acute, obtuse and right angles.
- Learning about regular/irregular shapes, different types of triangles & groups of quadrilaterals.

Unit 16 - Geometry - Position and Direction

- Coordinate grids to show positions of points.
- Translating shapes using coordinates and symmetry.

- Revision of surah Naba
- Tajweed: We will be focussing on the rule of Noon Sakina and Tanween. More specifically Ikhfaa. They will learn the 15 letters and apply the rule collectively and individually in their reading.

Arabic

- Children will be revising the present tense verbs in the singular form. They will go through a variety of short comprehension texts and answer the questions in Arabic.

Islamic Studies

- Children are memorising the hadith regarding the five rights of a Muslim in Arabic with its meaning.
- Recap of dua's to be read in Salah including the dua of salat al Janaza.

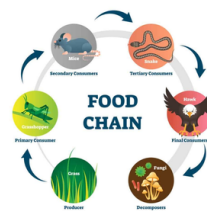
