Beowulf by Michael Morpurgo

Literary Theme - Mystery & truth

Main Outcome - Letter of Advice in Role

Writing - Use knowledge of morphology and etymology in spelling and understand that the spelling of some words needs to be learnt specifically.

Reading Comprehension - Distinguish between statements of fact and opinion.

Providing reasoned justifications for their views.



Robot Girl by Malorie Blackman and Matthew Griffin

Pupils will be identifying different types of figurative language in the text and evaluate how the author has used different styles of language.

Pupils will be practising spelling words with the 'ough' phoneme and learn to recognise and spell the suffixes cian/tion/ssion/sion. Pupils will research themes explored in the book to apply to their own independent writing.
