Maths

Unit 5 Geometry - Properties of shapes - 2D and 3D shapes

This unit draws on their skills of identifying similarities and differences and develops their skills of identifying patterns and sequences in shapes.

Unit 6 Number – Number and place value- Numbers to 20

Children will count in tens and ones, learning that they can partition 2-digit numbers. They will find the number that is one more or one less than a given number.

Unit 7 - Addition within 20

This unit builds on children's understanding of addition from Unit 3 and 4, as well as their knowledge of numbers to 20 from Unit 6. It requires children to understand how numbers can be split apart into bonds and how to represent numbers using manipulatives, as well as on number lines.

English

Phonics

Introducing Phase 3 sounds. Revision, spelling and handwriting of phase 2 and 3 sounds. Recognise and practise tricky words

Theme - Heroes and Villains

• I Want my Hat Back by Jan Klassen

During this sequence through role-play, they will explore a character's feelings. Making inferences on the basis of what is being said and done.

Participating in discussion, taking turns and listening to what others say. Sequencing sentences to form short narratives. Plan their own sequel called, 'I Want My Friend Back'.

• Billy and the Beast by Nadia Shireen

Children create their own version of the Billy character and use them to defeat a terrible beast. Give advice, write a letter and create their own versions of a Billy and the Beast story.

Reciting slowly with madd and ghunnah

Mixed short vowels word revision

Foundation Subjects


SCIENCE
