## **English**

Book: Winter's Child by Angela McAllister and Grahame Baker Smith

- Writing descriptive poems and fantasy stories.
- Placing the possessive apostrophe accurately in words.
- Using noun phrases expanded by the addition of adjectives.
- Inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives

& justifying inferences with evidence.

Book: Cinnamon by Neil Gaiman and Divya Srinivasan

- Preparing poems and play scripts to perform.
- Drawing inferences and justifying with evidence.
- Applying knowledge of root words, prefixes & suffixes.
- Punctuating direct speech.

## <u>Maths</u>

Multiplication & Division (2)

- Recalling multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12 × 12.
   Multiplying two-digit and threadigit number by a one-digit number up of formation.
- Multiplying two-digit and three-digit numbers by a one-digit number using formal written layout.
- Solving applied word problems involving multiplication and division.

#### Length and Perimeter

- This unit develops children's knowledge of units of measurement by introducing kilometre and using its equivalence to express distances in kilometres and metres.
- Children will then be introduced to the concept of perimeter as the distance around a 2D shape.

#### Fractions (1)

- This unit introduces the concept of mixed numbers and improper fractions.
- They will compare and order mixed numbers and will then look at how mixed numbers can be written as improper fractions and vice versa.
- They will then move on to equivalent fractions using fraction strips and a fraction wall to aid understanding of fraction families. Following this, children will further develop their understanding of how to simplify fractions.
