Literary Theme – Mystery & truth

Main Outcome – Letter of Advice in Role

Writing – Use knowledge of morphology and etymology in spelling and understand that the spelling of some words needs to be learnt specifically.

Reading Comprehension – Distinguish between statements of fact and opinion.

Providing reasoned justifications for their views.

The Lost Happy Endings by Carol Ann Duffy

Literary Theme – Legends & folklore

Main Outcome – Prequel Story – Alternative perspective

Writing – Spell some words with 'silent' letters. To distinguish between homophones and other words which are often confused.

Reading Comprehension – discussing and evaluating how authors use language, including figurative language, considering the impact on the reader.

Homework will be set every Friday and children are expected to complete the homework by Tuesday.

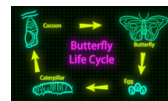
Writing for Pleasure – once a week writing task for children. No due date but children will be asked to bring back books to monitor their writing activity.
