- Different jobs and workers

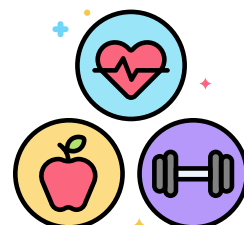

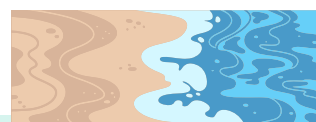
SCIENCE - Plants
