Fire Safety & Evacuation

What to Do

- The alarm is a loud, continuous siren.
- Proceed directly to the Dawlish Road assembly point (see map).
- If you discover a fire, alert the nearest staff member at once.
- Do not return inside until the all-clear is given.
- Staff will guide pupils out calmly and take the register at the assembly point.

Emergency Lockdown

Go to the nearest classroom or office immediately. Stay inside and wait until an official announcement says it's safe to leave.

Child Protection & Safeguarding

Report any concern about pupil safety or staff conduct to the School Office or the Designated Safeguarding Lead.

If a pupil discloses abuse (emotional, physical, sexual, or neglect):

- Don't promise secrecy—explain you must share this to protect them.
- Listen without interrupting or asking leading questions.
- Let them speak in their own words and at their own pace.
- Reassure them that support and protective action will follow.

Look out for signs such as unexplained injuries, poor hygiene, extremist language, or disturbing artwork. When in doubt, report to the Designated Safeguarding Lead. Always pass on any disclosure. Follow the same steps for suspected or reported bullying.

Smoking & Vaping

Smoking or vaping are not allowed on school premises for the benefit of pupils and staff.
