Ustadah Sidra

English

We will be reading the books named **The Invention of Hugo Cabret by Brian Selznick** and **The Suffragette: The Battle for Equality by David Roberts**.

The Battle for Equality by David Roberts. Our pupils will apply their growing knowledge of root words, prefixes and suffixes. Pupils will increase their familiarity with a wide range of books, including myths, legends and traditional stories, modern fiction, fiction from our literary heritage, and books from other cultures and traditions.



Maths

Unit 8: Algebra - Pupils will generalise mathematical concepts and problems, representing them algebraically as expressions, formulae and equations. Pupils begin by finding rules that govern number patterns.

Unit 9: Decimals - Pupils will draw on their understanding of number and place value to calculate with decimals. The learning from this unit will support children in calculating with measures, particularly converting between standard units, and it will support their understanding of fractions, decimals, and percentages, and how they are related.

Unit 10: Percentages - Pupils will learn a range of strategies to find percentages of amounts. They will then apply these strategies to convert between percentages, decimals, and fractions.

Foundation Subjects

Science

Evolution and Inheritance

Pupils will:

- Explore variation and inheritance in different living things and how observations and fossil evidence have led to the theory of evolution.

Geography

Topic: Where does our energy come from?

Pupils will learn to:

- Describe the significance of energy.
- Give examples of sources of energy and their trading routes.
- Describe the significance of the Prime Meridian.
- Discuss how transport links have changed over time.



Art

Topic: Art Illusions

Pupils will learn to look at how artists have used lines and shapes to create optical illusions, breaking down this mind-bending form of visual art into its basic principles.

PSHE/RHE/Wellbeing

Pupils will be learning about diet, oral hygiene, physical activity and the facts around immunisation. Exploring rest and relaxation and how they affect physical and mental health. Strategies for being resilient in challenging situations and planning for long-term goals.
