Literary Theme - Mystery & truth

Main Outcome – Letter of Advice in Role

Writing – Use knowledge of morphology and etymology in spelling and understand that the spelling of some words needs to be learnt specifically.

Reading Comprehension - Distinguish between statements of fact and opinion.

Providing reasoned justifications for their views.



### The Lost Happy Endings by Carol Ann Duffy

Literary Theme - Legends & folklore

Main Outcome - Prequel Story -Alternative perspective

Writing – Spell some words with 'silent' letters. To distinguish between homophones and other words which are often confused.

Reading Comprehension - discussing and evaluating how authors use language, including figurative language, considering the impact on the reader.




## Maths
