This book is about an enslaved brother and sister who are inspired by a majestic and mysterious bird to escape to freedom in this dramatic and unforgettable picture book.



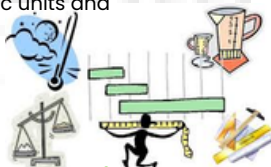
## Maths

### Unit 14 – Decimals 2

- Solve problems involving number up to three decimal places.
- Read, write, order and compare numbers with up to three decimal places.
- Recognise and use thousandths and relate them to tenths, hundredths and decimal equivalents.

### unit 16 – Measure

- Convert between different units of metric measure.
- Understand and use approximate equivalences between metric units and common imperial units such as inches, pounds and pints.
- Solve problems involving converting between units of time.
- Use all four operations to solve problems involving measure.

### SCIENCE

#### Human timeline



- Children will review their learning from this topic by covering the human timeline as a whole, from gestation to late adulthood.
- They will recap key information about each stage of the human life cycle, including at what age the stages begin and the key changes that occur during each stage (covered in Human Development lessons).
- Children will also explore data on life expectancy and how it has changed over time, challenging themselves to think about what could have caused such a change in life expectancy.

### History

#### What does census tell us about our local area?

Investigating local history during the Victorian period, children carry out an enquiry using census and factory records. They learn about the changes to a family over a period of time and suggest reasons for these changes, linking them to national events. Planning their own historical enquiry, they research a local family or street.
